#### Re: Mike Winters

Dear Mr. Costanzo and Chief Bustard:

I represent Mike Winters who, as you know, is a former Board member of Fire District #5.

On or about August 7, 2024 Jefferson Public Radio reported that the current District #5 Board has "concerns" about "potential impropriety" by an "unnamed former board member who had potentially used property that belonged to the district in a private manner." The report goes on to state that the Board is "looking into" the matter.

Mr. Winters has never been contacted by anyone connected with the District regarding any "potential impropriety" regarding District property, but because there are not many "former board members" and because he has been storing certain items belonging to the District on his land in Ashland, he asked me to contact you.

In 2023 Fire District #5 bought four 40-foot metal shipping containers. As Chief Bustard is well aware, he and then-Chief Hanley asked Mr. Winters if he would be willing to store those containers on his property until the District was ready to use them.

Not surprisingly, given his history of donating time, services, equipment and materials to the District, Mr. Winters not only agreed to store the four containers, but to do so at no expense to the District.

Chief Bustard and then-Chief Hanley met Mr. Winters on his land at 1577 N. Valley View Road so he could select an appropriate location for placement of the shipping containers. The District subsequently paid someone to move them onto Mr. Winters' land, where they have been sitting ever since.

The containers have been fully accessible to the District since they were delivered to Mr. Winters'

land. They have remained unused and empty, save for the addition of a 32 gallon plastic bag containing public records related to the District Mr. Winters placed inside one container so they could be readily retrieved by District personnel.

Given the Board's "concerns" about "potential impropriety", as reported by Jeffetson Public Radio, Mr. Winters is no longer willing to continue storing the District's containers on his land. Kindly have them removed no later than 30 days from today.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. R -4 -2024**

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DISTRICT PERSONNEL TO SIGN BANK DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the District has accounts with financial institutions; and

WHEREAS, it is in the District's best interest to delegate several District officials and personnel with the authority to sign financial documents and conduct other District business with financial institutions, while ultimate fiscal responsibility remains with the District Board; and

WHEREAS, the District Board, by this resolution, wishes to delegate signing authority to certain District officials and personnel.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF JACKSON COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT No. 5 AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Board of Directors designates the following District officials and personnel with signing authority when conducting business with financial institutions on behalf of the District:

- Fire Chief/Interim Fire Chief/Acting Fire Chief
- Designee of the Fire Chief/Interim Fire Chief/Acting Chief
- Board Chair
- Board Vice Chair

Section 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon its enactment by the Board of Directors.
